Dear Church Family,



### THE FERNDALE PANTRY





The need in our communities continues to grow. Each Social Saturday finds new families seeking support. Currently, we feed 20-30 families supporting approximately 60-70 people twice a month. On any given Saturday, we disperse:

10-15 jars of spaghetti sauce
10-15 boxes of cereal
10-15 boxes of pancake mix and syrup
10-15 packets of tuna
10-15 cans of tuna/chicken
10-15 cans of corn
6-8 bags of white/yellow rice
6-8 boxes of pop tarts
6-8 cans of peaches/mixed fruit
6-8 skillet meals
6-8 cans of vegetables
6-8 boxes of shelf-stable milk: whole, 2%, almond



Operation Christmas Child is a year-long project. LHUMC's goal for 2025 is 850 packed shoeboxes. We can achieve that goal with your help. We will be collecting items each month. January- hats scarves and mittens, February –Valentine novelty items & fashion accessories (hair bows, sun glasses, hair ties, necklaces, friendship bracelets, etc) March – St Patrick's novelty items, stuffed animals and plastic Easter eggs (need 63 dozen). Please placed donated items in the Christmas box in the narthex. Check out the display and the newsletter for future items.

If you have any of the following items on hand at home, consider donating them also. Did you craft using card stock and stampers and don't use them anymore. We have a purpose for them...making book marks. We will upcycle the following into new items: hard eye glass cases, old T-shirts any color, plastic soda bottle caps, bottled water caps, old sweat shirts or sweat pants, pillow cases, colored or printed sheets, sewing notions-double fold bias tape, rick-rack, thread etc.

Additionally, we will begin meeting on February 6th and meet each Thursday from 6-8pm in the unity room (room 109) to make items for the shoe boxes.
